

Polystyrene core

For ensured accuracy, lightweight polystyrene is cut to shape using the latest water jet technology. With 28mm polystyrene used in the side walls and roof, all Swift motorhomes meet the Grade 3 thermal properties needed for year-round adventures.

GRP

Manufactured at Swift, our GRP (glass reinforced plastic) front and rear panels are robust and resilient. The side panels feature outer and inner GRP skins of the same thickness to create a balanced panel which allows the motorhome to expand and contract in different climatic conditions.

Unlike other manufacturers, our GRP inner skin does not use any jointing tape - all Swift motorhomes have a jointless sealing in the walls, and are embellished with wallpaper finishes.

It must fit the manufacturer's approved mounting points and must not obscure the towing vehicle's number plate.
